**From The Desk of Msgr. Corrigan:**

Good news on our financial situation. Our increased Giving Campaign is going well. We have had an increase in our Sunday collections of a \$1,000.00 per week. Was this due to an increase in individual giving of our regular parishioners (registered from the past years) or from new parishioners (especially from new parents of children in our religious education program)? Either way, it is a welcome sign of the generosity of our parish.

Cardinal's Annual Stewardship Appeal. The 2014 goal for our parish was set at \$30,000.00. The total amount pledged as of October 16 was \$36,175.50. The total amount received as of October 16 was \$34,200.50. Our rebate (60% of cash received over goal) was \$2,220.30. This was the highest amount in many years.

Additions to our Mass schedule:

On Thanksgiving Day in addition to our regularly scheduled 8:15am and 12:05pm Masses, we will have a bilingual (English-Spanish) Mass at 10:00 am. Participants are encouraged to bring non-perishable food for the hungry.

There will be a Spanish speaking Mass at 7:00pm on Thursday and 7:30pm Mass on Saturday evenings. Bilingual Confessions (English/Spanish) will be heard every Monday, Friday and Saturday from 11:45am to 12:00pm.

Our Annual Dinner Dance will take place next Saturday, November 22<sup>nd</sup> at 7pm. Tickets are \$50.00 and can be obtained at the rectory. I encourage you to come.
