On April 2 at 6:30 pm our parish will celebrate Holy Thursday. This celebration of the Lord's Supper begins the Triduum (The Three Days) of the Pascal Mystery. This evening includes the celebration of the first Mass (the night before he died, Jesus took bread, broke it and gave it to his disciples"), the institution of the priesthood ("Do this in memory of me") and the washing of the feet. This year I want to make this night a festive occasion to bring all our parishioners together. It is the one of the few times that our Spanish and English speaking congregations can celebrate together. It will also be an opportunity to thank our parishioners who volunteer their services during the year e.g. priests, Members of the Parish Council, Eucharistic Ministers, Lectors, Ushers, Altar Servers, Choir Members, Leaders of Song, Teachers of Religious Instruction, those who clean the alter, counters the money, sell the candles, clean and cook in our cafeteria and parish hall etc. I as pastor will thank them in the ceremony of the washing of the feet. "The Son of Man takes up a towel and washes the feet of his followers, then calls them to do the same. The new church, lead by Pope Francis, is to be a community of brothers and sisters sent out to wash the feet of the world". Please put April 2, 2015 at 6:30 pm in your calendar.
