Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity (year C)

From The Desk of Msgr. Corrigan:

Last week we tried to comprehend the staggering vastness of the universe. A telephone call (which travels at the speed of light) to the moon would take one second. A telephone call to the farthest galaxy from us (Andromeda) would take 2.5 million years. All this is governed by laws of nature (maybe not all, but that is another story). This knowledge (which we have acquired only in the last hundred years) leads some to atheism. For many others there is no need to eliminate God. The main question for us about God is not whether he exists but what kind of God is God. God can seem very remote from us human beings living on this planet, Earth. That is why today's celebration of the Holy Trinity is so helpful. Here is a God that is constantly telling us that He does care for us. God cares for us as a parent does. To bring this reality closer to us, He sent His Son to us not as an alien but as one of us. When the Son returned to his Father, God sent His Spirit to remain with us until the end of our world.

So when we look out at the stars and start to feel insignificant, think about today's celebration and be at peace.
