In this spirit of unity, we will celebrate a special trilingual Mass on Thanksgiving morning, November 24th at 9:00am. There will be no 8:15am Mass that day but there will be a 12:05 Mass.

Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe: The history of this solemnity is rather interesting. The complete title of today's feast tells it all. We celebrate the supreme authority and power of Jesus Christ, Messiah, over all people, nations, and the universe. Established in 1923 by Pope Pius XI as a reaction to nationalism and Fascism, this celebration is unusual in that it doesn't mark an event in the life of Jesus. It is however, rooted in the celebration of Christ's Ascension, but was placed at the end of the liturgical year because of the eschatological nature of the autumnal and liturgical season.

First Reading: 2 Samuel 5:1-3 - Because David was so loved as a leader, the elders of all the tribes anointed him King of Israel at Hebron. King David shepherded the people from then on.

Responsorial Psalm: Psalm 121- "What a joy when they told me "Let's go to the house of the Lord"!"

Second Reading Colossians 1:12-20 - God's Son brought the people into the reign of forgiveness and love. He heads the body, the church, and has primacy in all things, making peace through the blood of his cross.

Gospel: Luke 23:35-43- The soldiers made fun of Jesus on the cross, offered him bitter wine, told him to save himself if he was the Christ. They put an inscription over his head "This is the King of the Jews".
