Third Sunday in Ordinary Time (A)

From the Desk of Rev. Msgr. Hugh J. Corrigan:

We are in the middle stages of our major fundraising campaign, called "Renew+Rebuild". Here at St. Mary's we will use the money raised (74% of the total) to repair our stained glass windows. As we have done in previous capital improvement projects (1992, 1998, 2008), we will erect a wall plaque in the foyer of the church. On it will be inscribed the names of all the donors who have pledged a certain amount of money. On the first line of the plaque will be written the name of the donor. If the donor wishes, a second line will be added on which will be written the name of a person the donor wants to honor or remember e.g. Peter Jones, in Memory of My Parents. Or for the living: In Honor of My Uncle. To see this more clearly, look at the fundraising plaques in the foyer of our church.

There will be different categories depending on the amount of money pledged:

- ❖ Benefactor: \$10,000+
- ❖ Patron: \$ 7,500 +
- ❖ Sponsor: \$ 5,000 +
- ❖ Provider: \$ 2,500 +
- ❖ Contributor: \$ 1,000 +
- ❖ Donor: \$ 500 +

Responsorial Psalm: Psalm 27:1,4

"The Lord is my light and my Salvation!"

2nd Reading: 1 Corinthians 1:10-13

Paul wrote to the people of Corinth: let "there be no divisions among you...be united in mind and in the same purpose". I have heard "that there are rivalries among you...Is Christ divided?"

Gospel: Matthew 4:12-23

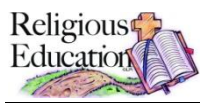
