Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity (A)

From the Desk of Rev. Msgr. Hugh J. Corrigan:

We are honored to have Fr. Rodolfo Casals S.J. celebrate his first Mass at St. Mary's at the 9a.m. Mass today. All are invited to participate. After the Mass there will be a reception for him in our Parish Hall where you may receive his first blessing as a priest. Food will be served. In a time of decreasing vocations to the priesthood, it is hoped that he will inspire young men to enter the seminary.

Our Renew+Rebuild Campaign is in its last stages. The goal set for us was \$409,000. So far we have pledges totaling \$384,182. The Campaign will be sending out letters to those parishioners who have made a pledge but have not yet sent in any payments. Let us hope we will reach our goal. Thank you to all of you who have already made pledges.

The work on our stained glass windows will begin in September. I just signed the contract. There will be two stages this year. If there is enough money from the Campaign there will be third and fourth stages in the future. The first stage will take care of all the sanctuary windows, all the chapel windows and all the windows (except the rose window) on the front of the church (South Broadway). The second stage will take care of the rose window in the front of the church. A rose window is very expensive because of its many parts. If there are no costly repairs in our first stage, we will be able to afford to repair this rose window almost immediately—hopefully using the same scaffolding (which is very expensive). Perhaps this second stage will include the eight windows in the south side in the nave of the church. We then have to wait until the payments of pledges start bringing in more money. Then we can repair the other two rose windows (the third and fourth stage).

Collection : the collection for last Sunday, June 4, 2017 was \$3,717.00

The second collection this Sunday will be our Father's Day Mass Remembrance collection. The envelopes with the names of those Father's which we will remember will be placed on the altar during the Father's Day Novenas.

First Reading; Exodus 34:4b-6 page 40: Moses went up Mount Sinai to meet the Lord, he begged the Lord to accompany the Israelites, "a stiff-necked people". He asked God to pardon their wickedness and sins.

Second Reading; 2Corinthians 13:11-13: page 41: Paul encouraged the Corinthians to mend their sinful ways and help one another live in peace.

Gospel; John 3:16-18 page 41: God loved the world so greatly that he sent his only Son that all may have eternal life. The Son did not come to condemn the world but that it might be saved through him. Whoever believes in the Lord will live forever.
