Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time (A)

From the Desk of Rev. Msgr. Hugh J. Corrigan:

As historic as the "Declaration of Independence" is, the more important document is the "Constitution of the United States". We all know that the former document was adopted on July 4, 1776 as justification for the Revolutionary War. The war formally ended on September 3, 1783. On June 21, 1788 the new "Constitution" was ratified. The Bill of Rights was added on December 13, 1791. It is a remarkable document. It is even more remarkable that it was approved (eventually) by all thirteen original states. Instead of one nation we could have become three nations (new England, Mid-Atlantic, Southern States).

Compromises were made. The worst was allowing slavery. The second was the three-fifths rule: even though slaves could not vote, they counted as 3/5 of the total. This allowed the southern slave states to dominate the House of Representatives. Eleven of our first thirteen Presidents were slave owners.

The other parts of the document are remarkable: Separation of church and state, separated powers (executive, legislative, judicial), federalism, bicameralism (Senate and House of Representatives), and independent judiciary. It became a model for the world.
