From the Desk of Rev. Msgr. Hugh J. Corrigan:

Our hearts and prayers are offered to the people of Huston, Texas, who are suffering because of the enormous rainstorms and flooding. Because of worldwide climate changes these disasters will become more frequent in the future. It is one of the reasons we are about to repair and protect our stained glass windows. Last week we achieved our pledged goal of \$409,000. for the Renew + Rebuild Campaign. 26% of the total (\$71,000) will be paid for Archdiocesan priorities. Another \$35,000 has already been paid for the 2017 Cardinal's Appeal. If everyone fulfills their pledges over the next four years we will have \$300,000 to do the windows. Thanks to the money from the estate of George Russ, we can begin the work immediately. Work should be started in three weeks. It is not too late to donate money for this project. A donation of at least \$500 will place your name on our donor plaque in our vestibule. The more money we receive the more stained glass windows we can add to the project.

Thank you to our Mexican community for their donation from the proceeds of last Sunday's celebration.
