"Take time to smell the roses". Although it is literally true at this time of the year (our spring roses are now blooming). It is a wisdom proverb. It means that we can become so preoccupied with the tasks and problems of daily living that we don't allow ourselves the time to enjoy some of the joys of life. I thought of this last week while I was walking in the convent garden. Instead of just enjoying this beautiful garden, I spent most of my time pulling up weeds. So I stopped and sat down on one of the benches for twenty minutes and absorbed the sights and smells of the flowers.
